Keep the group active. You can encourage people in the group to get to know at least 1-2 others in the group.

Have a point of contact for Civil Defence emergencies.

Report neighbours' crime incidents to the police. members are responsible for reporting their own crime incidents to police, however it is a good idea to let the group know if a crime has occurred in the neighbourhood, so they are aware.

Send out Crime Reports or Newsletters from us. These will be sent out to your members automatically if we have their email information on our database.
